A.P. Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Sub Plan

1. The Govt. of AP has enacted “The AP SCSP & TSP (Planning, Allocation & Utilisation of Financial Resources) Act, 2013”. (Act.No.1 of 2013).
2. In the State of AP, SC Population is **17.1 percent** and ST population is **5.53 percent** including 7 mandals of Khammam District (5 complete and 2 partial) which were tentatively added to the State of Andhra Pradesh as per A.P Reorganization Ordinance 2014. These percentages have to be considered while formulating the state plan schemes and budget estimates from the financial year 2014-15
3. The State council for development of SC’s and ST’s under the Chairmanship of Hon’ble Chief Minister advises State Govt. on all policy matters related to SC and ST and also suggest measures to District Monitoring Committee under the chairmanship of District Collector. The district monitoring committee shall coordinate and shall cause the maintenance of scheme wise, village wise and beneficiary wise details of both physical and financial benefits and the details shall be placed in the web portal for tracking the progress of the implementation, expenditure, output and outcome indicators as may be prescribed in Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan and Tribal Sub-Plan.
4. BEs under State Development Plan schemes and Centrally Assisted State Development Plan schemes for the year 2018-19 under SCSP is **44482.39 Lakhs** and TSP is **13402.57 Lakhs** respectively.
5. The act is to ensure accelerated development of SC and ST farmers with emphasis on achieving equality in the next 10 years focusing on economic, educational and human development along with ensuring security, social dignity and promoting equity among SC’s, ST’s and other social groups.
6. Bridge the gaps of backwardness among various social groups within the SC’s and ST’s and economic, financial viability of the schemes.
7. The Nodal agencies i.e Social Welfare and Tribal Welfare will review periodically on the progress on implementation of SCSP & TSP under the Chairmanship of concerned Hon’ble Minister.
8. Percentage of subsidy enhanced from **50 percent to 70 percent** under farm mechanization to benefit more no. of SC & ST farmers for better crop production. As per 2010-11 census of A.P
