ORDER:-

In the reference 1st read above, the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) has submitted the World Bank project proposal on Andhra Pradesh Integrated Irrigation and Agriculture Transformation Project (APIIATP) with an object to enhance agriculture productivity, profitability and climate resilience of small holder farmers in selected districts of Andhra Pradesh at an estimated cost of Rs.1600 Crores i.e., Rs.1120 crores (70%) as World Bank share and Rs.480 crores (30%) as Government of Andhra Pradesh Share.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, the Advisor to Government of Andhra Pradesh, Agriculture & Cooperation Department & Co-Vice Chairman, Rythu Sadhikara Samstha has submitted the action plan to implement Zero Budget Natural Farming in 827 Gram Panchayats (GPs)where APIIATP is being implemented.

- I. Implementing ZBNF in the APIIATP Villages furthers the objectives of APIIATP and ZBNF simultaneously.
- II. APIIATP's goal is to improve irrigation and transform agriculture with climate resilience as a crosscutting theme. Apart from improving irrigated agriculture efficiency, the project has specific focus on promoting climate smart agriculture practices. Total number of GPs to be covered are 827 across all districts in the state.
- III. ZBNF's objective is to convert the farm families to climate resilient zero-budget natural farming on a saturation basis.
- IV. Thus, there is a complete sync between the two projects. Therefore, it is proposed to take up ZBNF implementation in these 827 GPs starting with 2019 itself.
- V. Cost of implementing ZBNF in one GP to cover all farmers is Rs. 1.22 crore spread over 6 years (start year plus five years) in that GP with an average cost per farmer estimated at Rs. 26,220 for 6-year period. Start year requires Rs. 4.25 lakh per GP.

VIII. Estimated funds of **Rs. 1,008 crore** is required to fully implement ZBNF in **all 827 GPs** in all 6 years. **Start year requires Rs. 35 crore. And first 3 years require Rs.517 Crore.**

Funds Available

- IX. Funds available for agriculture under APIIATP are: **Rs. 298.6** crore over a period of 7 years. Funding components under APIIATP that are most relevant for implementing ZBNF programme include:
 - Enhancing Crop Production by Crop Diversification and Intensification through sub-components such as seeds, soil health management,
 - Demonstrations on crop diversifications and intensification
 - Efficient Water use
- X. Cluster development as per ZBNF scaling-up plan requires one internal CRP to be deployed in a GP in the first year and gradually increased to a steady state. A steady state cluster team will be as follows:

Accordingly, Government hereby order to implement ZBNF action plan under APIIATP in 827 GPs spread over all the districts of Andhra Pradesh starting with 2019 itself.

5. The Advisor to Government of Andhra Pradesh, Agriculture & Cooperation Department & Co-Vice Chairman, Rythu Sadhikara Samstha is requested to take further necessary action, accordingly.
